



## Janet Graham

August 7, 1922 - February 7, 2018

Janet Rainsford Graham, age 95, passed to her heavenly Father on February 7, 2018 at her St. Augustine home, surrounded by family. From her birthplace in Bryn Mawr, PA, on August 7, 1922 until her death, she nourished her family and people around her with love, faith, compassion and hope. She was born to Charles and Bonnie Rainsford and was the eldest of four children. Janet was preceded in death by her brothers Ed and Glenn, and sister, Pat. Janet will be remembered as a bright, shining light in the communities, schools and churches she served. Janet served as a Red Cross volunteer aid in Bryn Mawr Hospital for over twenty-five years.

Janet married her high school sweetheart, WWII Navy pilot, Ltr. Commander R. John Graham, in 1944 in Bryn Mawr, PA. After World War II the young couple started their life together in Wayne, PA. In 1992, Janet and John retired to St. Augustine, FL. After John's passing in 2002, Janet dedicated her energies to the Corpus Christi Catholic Church and served on the Ladies Guild in any way she could to help the church. She was regarded by church founder, Father William C. Mooney, as "someone who will never be replaced".

Left to honor Janet are three children, Robert (Bonnie) Graham, Marcy (Darrell) Moore, and Leslie Graham Bendt; seven grandchildren: Christian (Shannon) Moore, Cheektowaga, NY; Former First Sergeant Robert J. Graham III, Woodbridge, VA; Dr. Danielle (Dr. William) Carlezon, Boston, MA; Andrew (Jennifer) Moore, Orchard Park, NY; Jenna (Jake) Shaw, Luxembourg; Lindsay Bendt and Calen Bendt, both of St. Augustine, FL.
