



## Patricia A. (Spurrier) Lisk

Patricia Ann (Spurrier) Lisk, age 74, of St Augustine, FL passed away peacefully on December 10, 2020 at Westminster St. Augustine after a long battle with cancer. Throughout the fight she was always positive, strong, and courageous to the very end. Pat was born in Charlotte, NC to her loving parents, Earnest and Elvaree Spurrier, and lived there for 18 years before getting married and moving to Satellite Beach, FL. Several years after having a son, Pat and family moved to the suburbs of Atlanta where she lived and worked for the majority of her life before relocating back to Florida.

Pat began her career in the insurance business with Wausau Insurance Company in the early 1970's and officially retired with H&H Insurance in 2019. She loved her work and was dedicated to doing the best job possible in both her personal life and professional life. A coworker summed her up perfectly when she said - "your Mom was a phenomenal woman and meant the world to me, filled with love, laughter, ethics, and a good heart." Regardless of how long you knew her, everyone who had the pleasure of knowing Pat felt exactly the same way.

In 2011 Pat decided it was time to move to Florida, along with her two dogs, to enjoy semi-retirement and be closer to her grandchildren. She would often be seen on the sidelines supporting Adah and William at soccer games, baseball games and gymnastics meets, or exploring North Florida with new friends. She loved walking her dogs, sightseeing, playing games, eating out, frozen yogurt, and the occasional glass of wine.

Pat is survived by her son and daughter-in-law, Greg and Alyse Lisk, two grandchildren, Adah and William, and her grand dog Stanley. She was preceded in death by her parents, Earnest Leighton and Elvaree Taylor Spurrier, and her beloved dogs, Sam and Rambeau.
